The innovative company has partnered with Kanye West engineer, Anthony Kilhoffer, to deliver their user-investor community a career-changing opportunity to collaborate in-studio in a competitive drive to close out their Reg CF campaign. The company is actively raising a \$2M private round in parallel.

"We're totally thrilled and humbled to receive recognition from the likes of *Fast Company* and *Music Week*," says Josh Simons, co-founder of Vampr. "We're proud that our work so far is getting the recognition it deserves, and we're committed to further radical innovation in the future."

Further, Vampr has a number of big announcements lined up for the spring, including the launch of an education platform during the NOLA Music Tech summit that Vampr promises will amplify their members' ability to pursue their greatest music industry aspirations.
